Washington, DC Office The MRF office in Washington, DC, which acts as a clearinghouse for tracking motorcycle related legislation in the states and in Congress.

National & Regional Conferences Sponsorship of an annual national conference (Meeting of the Minds) and two regional conferences (Best of the West and Beast of the East) for motorcyclists to gather and share knowledge and skills.

Training & Motivation Meetings offering topflight training in politics, leadership, planning and organizational skills. These skills are necessary to win the support and favor of civic leaders, lawmakers, the media and other centers of influence.

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation

It all started in 1985 when many state motorcycle rights organization leaders came together for a "Meeting of The Minds". They wanted to catapult the clout of their organizations, the strong, effective grassroots of statebased motorcyclists' rights, onto a national level. From this meeting, a new leader was born: The Motorcycle Riders Foundation, Inc.

They Knew it Had to be Done Right

They envisioned an organization committed to values such as respect for riders' diverse lifestyles and opinions, integrity in conduct, excellence and boldness in facing challenges, teamwork in attaining goals, and above all: leadership in the unrelenting struggle for the safety and freedom of American motorcyclists. Motorcyclists' rights had to go national, because the threat was national. In 1987, danger was not just on the horizon but dead ahead: freedom's foes had just attacked with a ban on motorcycles in the U.S. Congress.

The MRF is the first motorcyclists' rights advocacy organization with a full-time political presence in our nation's Capitol, and the only Washington voice devoted exclusively to you, the street rider.

Together We Will:

Preserve rider access to America's roadways.

Make roadways safer.

Safeguard your right to individualize your motorcycle.

Continue to monitor the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and hold them accountable.



MRF National Recognition

1987 The MRF, working with grass-roots activists, stopped legislation that would ban the sale of "superbikes".

1991 MRF was instrumental in removing all references to "Motorcycle" from the DeConcini Outlaw Gang Bill.

1995 MRF and our SMRO Partners succeed in repealing the federal helmet law blackmail against the states.

1998 MRF and SMROs persuade Congress to include NHTSA Lobby Ban and prohibition of motorcycle bans on federally funded roads in Transportation Funding bill.

2000 MRF and New England motorcyclists came together to stop Helmet Law.

2001 Health Insurance Discrimination rules challenged.

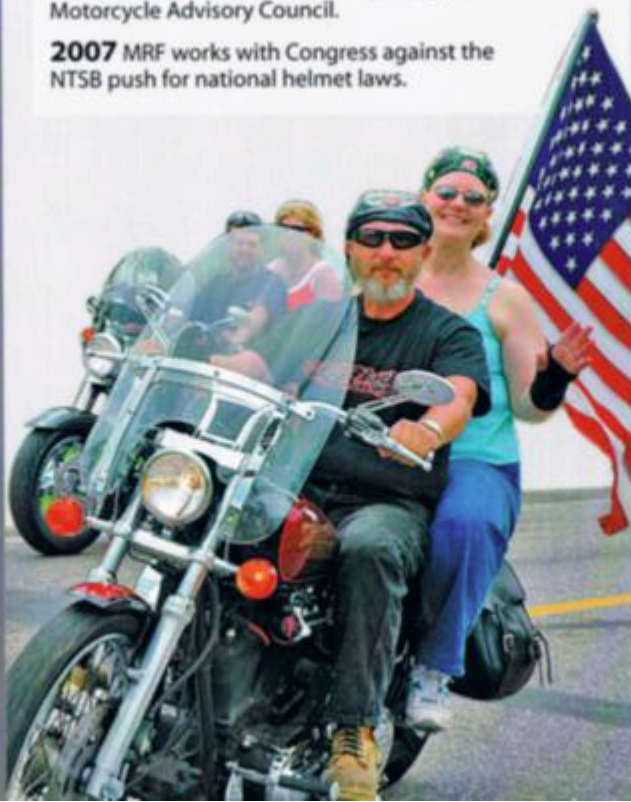
2004 MRF releases "EPA for the Layman" for highway motorcycles.

2005 MRF was instrumental in defeat of Senator Lautenberg's national helmet law amendment.

2006 MRF ushered 44 states into the Federal Motorcycle Safety Program, obtaining grants totaling \$6 million per year for State motorcycle safety programs.

2006 MRF was a key player in creating the National Motorcycle Advisory Council.

2007 MRF works with Congress against the NTSB push for national helmet laws.

MEMBERSHIP LEVELS:

Individual: \$30 annually or \$80 for 3 years¹.
